





## Provenance Research



In 2004 a project was launched together with a team of library trainees to examine the so-called "Tanzenberg Collection" in the holdings of the Vienna University Library. The scope of the project has since been expanded to include provenance research on looted books which were acquired by the Main Library between 1938 and 1945. More recently, in March 2006, a new project was started to focus on the holdings of the 50 sublibraries, which are part of the University Library itself.

## Restitution cases in u: search

Books that have already been restituted or are due for restitution can be retrieved via [u: search](#).

The date of the restitution, the name of the previous owner and, if possible, of the recipient is recorded in the copy information. Only restitution cases are completed, or those where the decision to restitution has already been taken, but this could not yet be carried out - for example due to unknown previous owners or heirs. The stocks concerned are continuously incorporated.

You can find the affected copies of the UB Vienna in the following search results:

- Restituted volumes
- Restrictions provided for restitution
- All volumes affected by restitution

The examples on the individual restitution cases are linked in the short texts under [restitutions](#).

In addition, you can search in a free search for individual restitution cases, origin notes or specific time periods. To do this, select the "Signature" category in the Advanced Search and combine the phrase "NS-Robbery" with the name you are looking for. For restitution of a certain period of time, look for "Restitution 2011" in the signature field.








