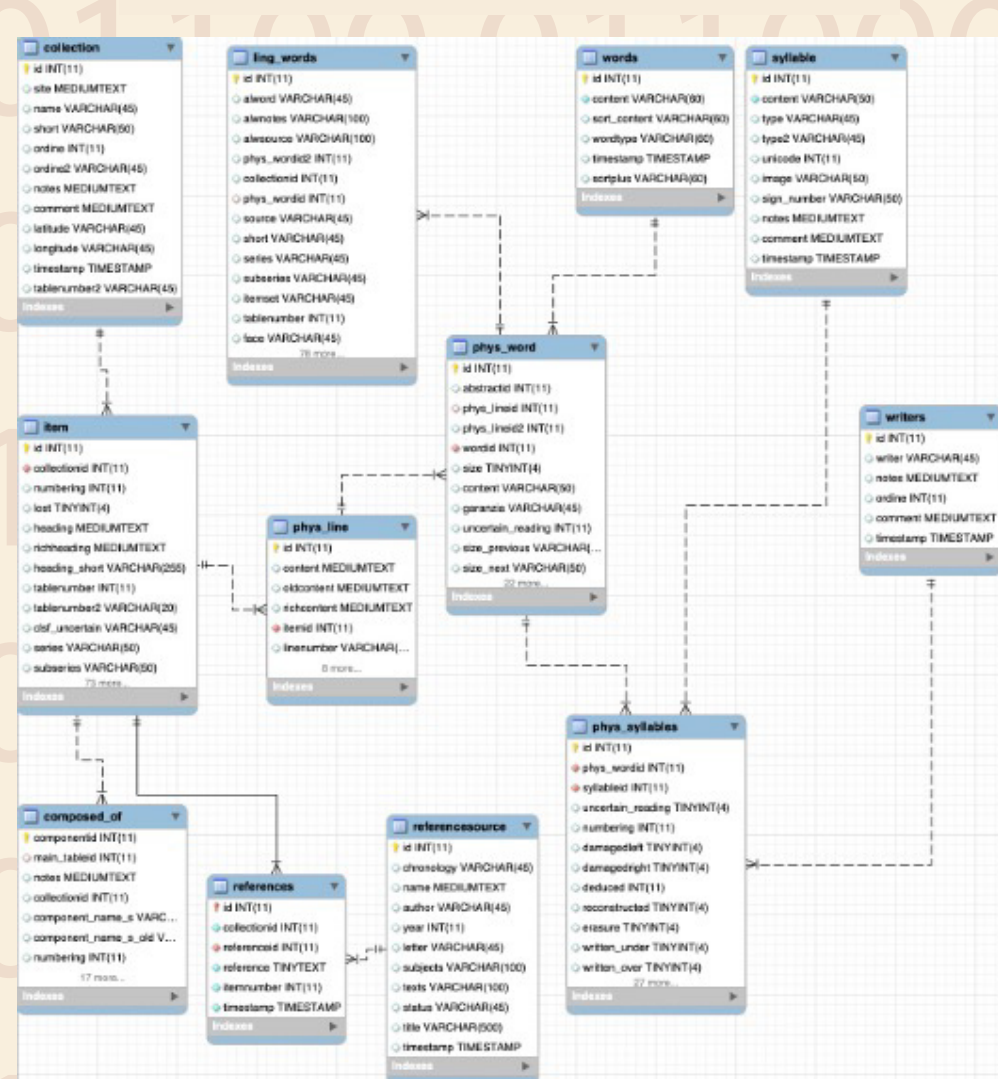
PROJECT GOALS

- Create the **foundation for a common national platform** for DSEs to ensure their long term accessibility according to **FAIR** principles

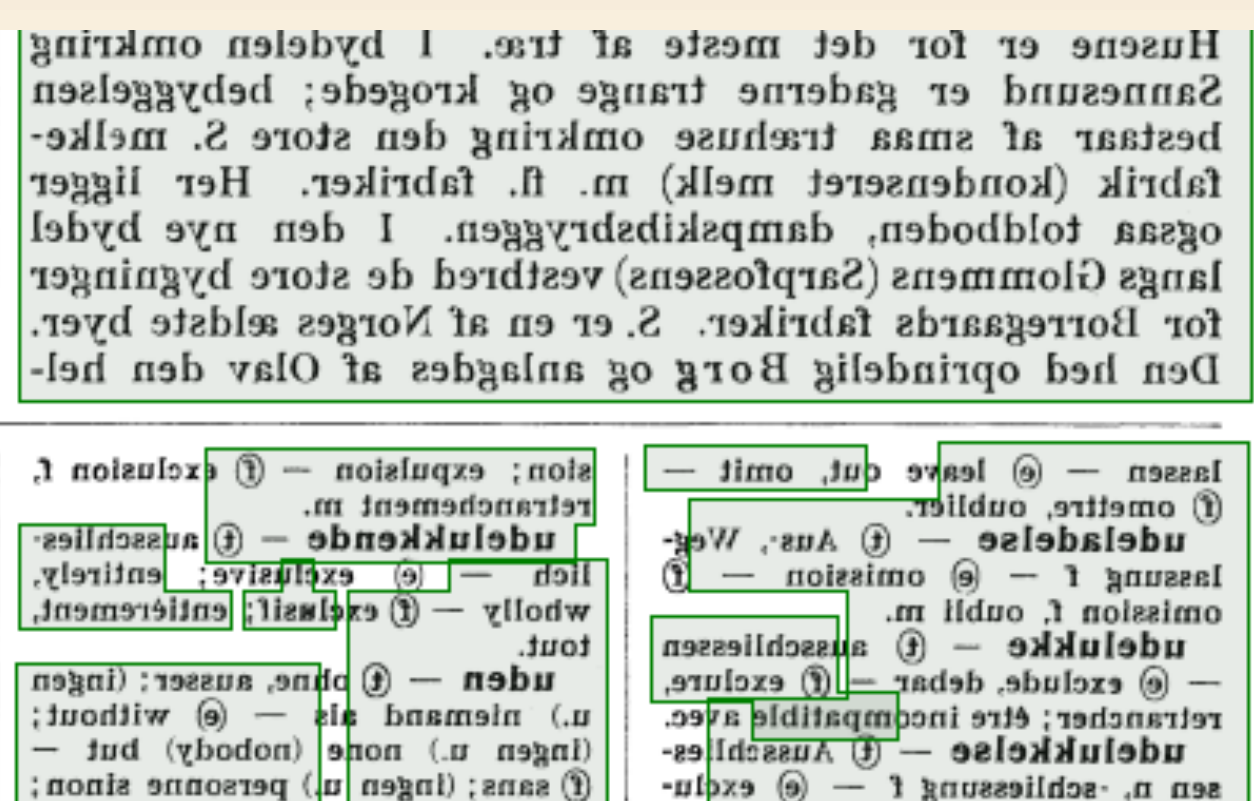

- White paper and recommendation for a national infrastructure.

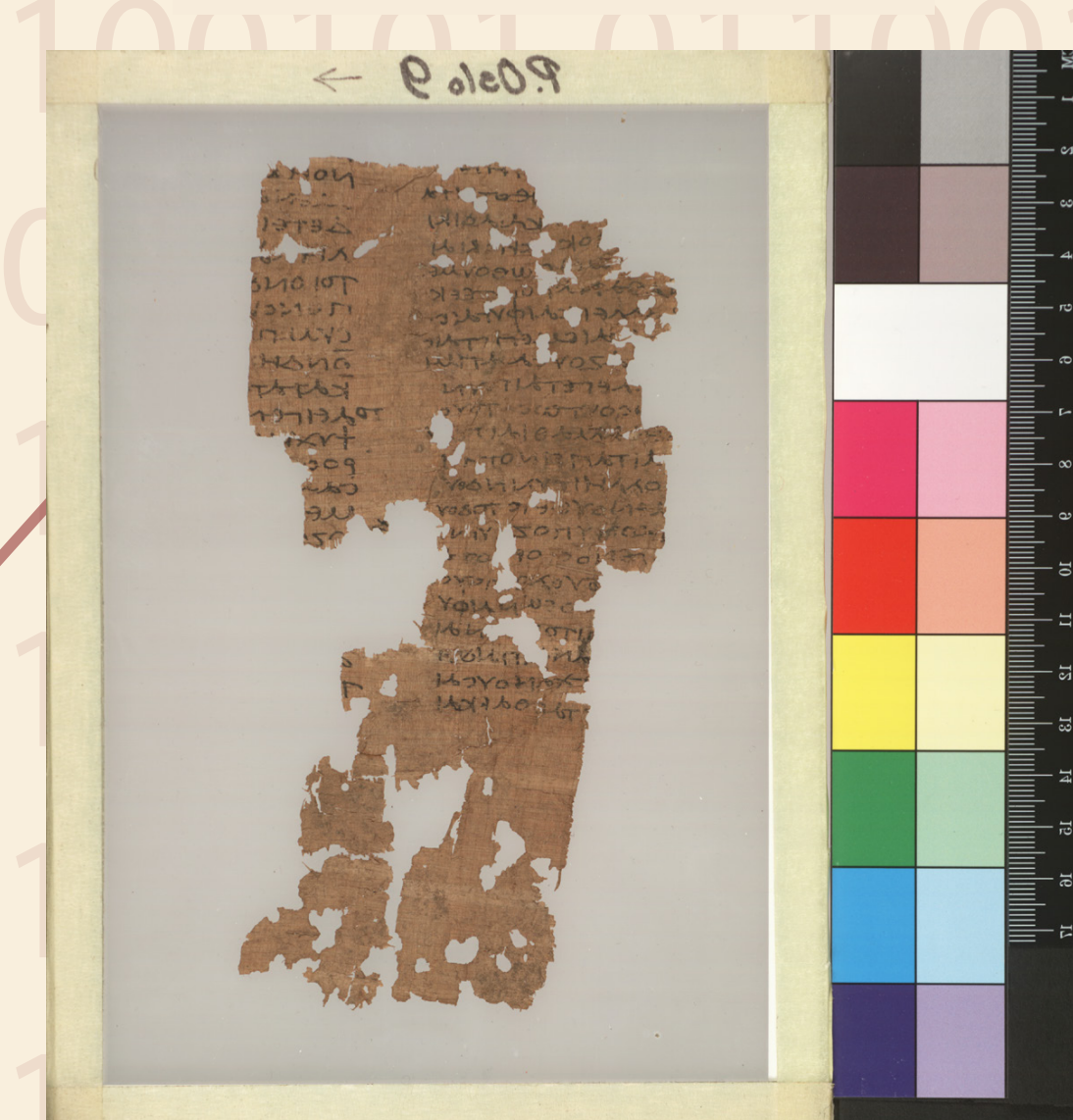

Automatic Text Recognition (OCR)



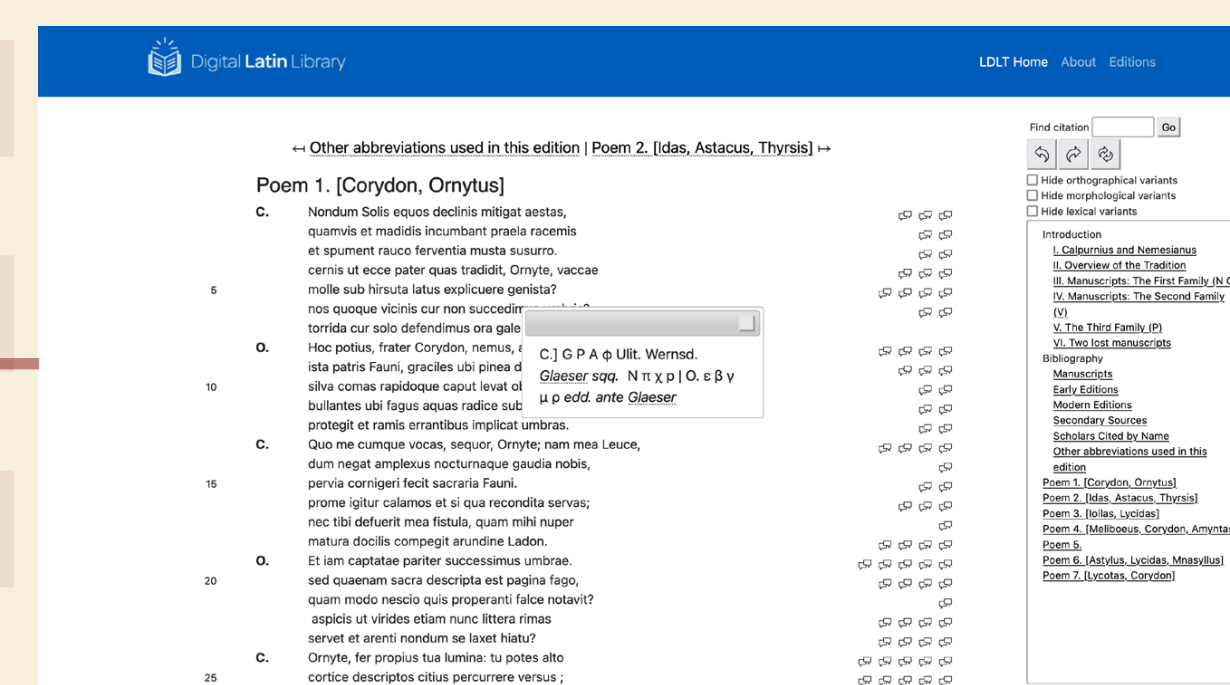

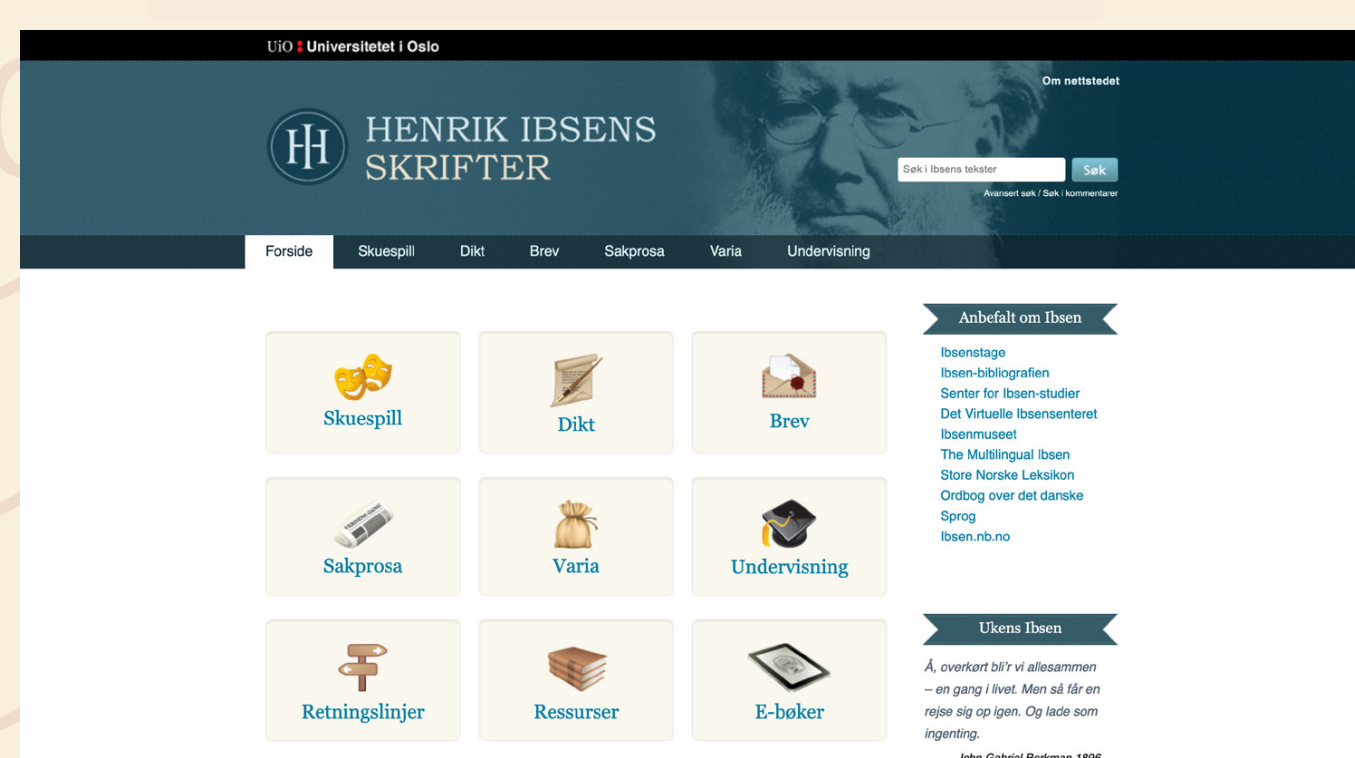

MAPPING THE STATE OF DSEs IN NORWAY

Systematically mapping existing and planned DSEs, with a focus on:

- Philological details and their visualisation
- Structure and content
- Search functions & accessibility
- Curation and archiving
- Encoding, programming & linked data
- Licenses & documentation

FEASIBILITY STUDY

The mapping will lead to a feasibility study with the aim to identify conditions, frameworks, procedures, and infrastructures necessary for **sustainable** long-term archiving and accessibility and conduct a feasibility study.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The last stage of the project will be concerned with the development of a **white paper** containing recommendations for establishing an infrastructure for DSEs at the national level.
