- Contributes to bibliodiversity

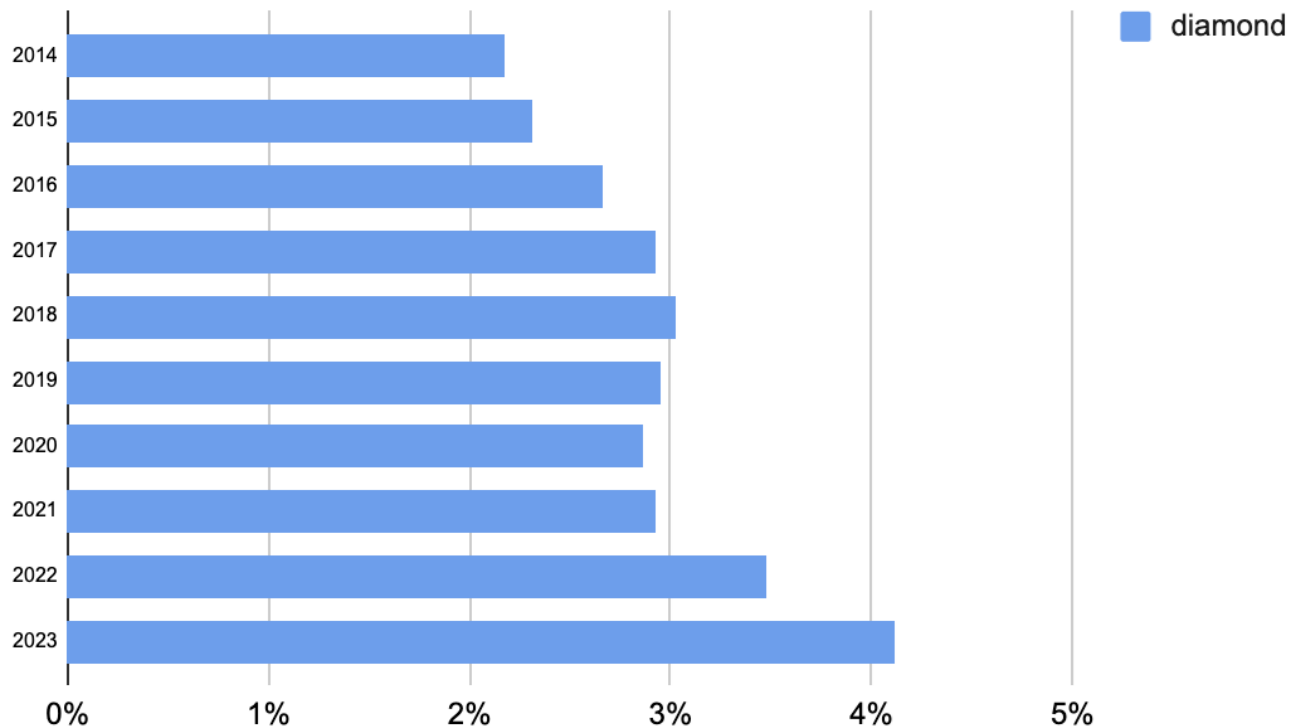


Diamond Open Access in the Netherlands

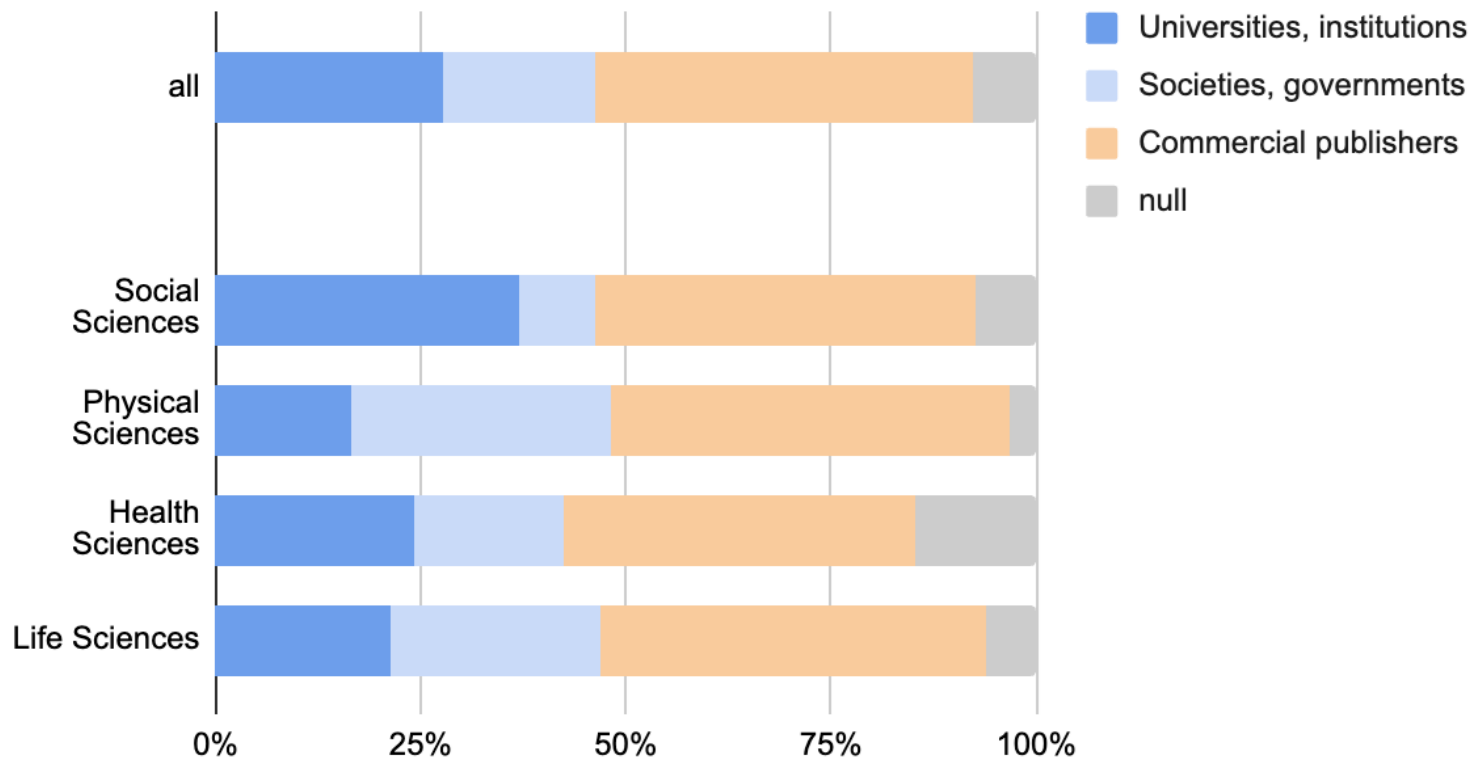


Journal articles (publication years 2018-2023, NL affiliations)

OA percentages (OpenAlex 20241030)

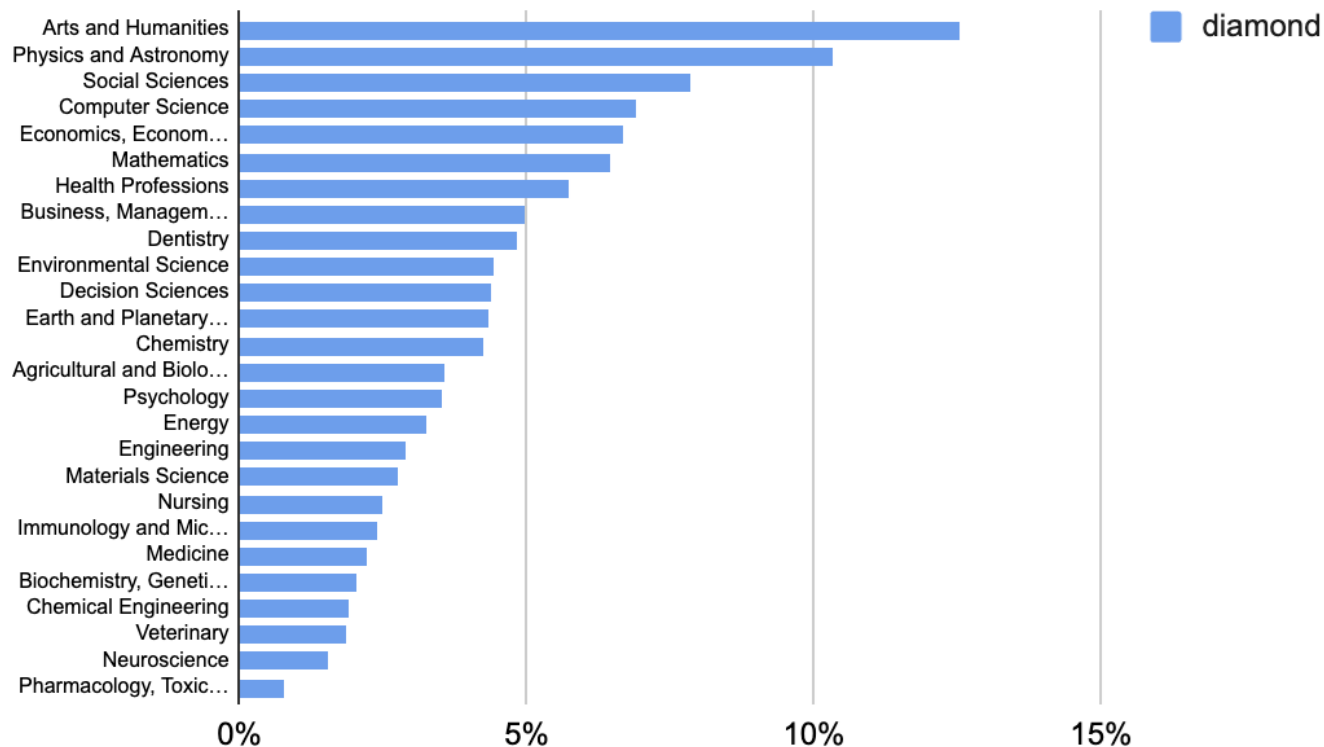


Journal articles (publication year, 2023, NL affiliations, diamond OA) publisher types (OpenAlex 20241030, GOA2024)
